

Impress – Sharing content

The impress service neither downloads nor retains any data. It is 'just' a web service for viewing content.

1. Het proces

Here is a brief explanation of the current process: The content located on a cloud storage is always loaded directly to the client (the device used for viewing) and then displayed there by impress. Therefore, each time a user wants to view the content, he needs to have the rights to actually access the content. This is entirely done on the company side which provides the cloud storage (e.g. OneDrive Admin center). Otherwise, the owner would have no control over whether and to whom access is granted.

This can also be found in the help: "To use impress, you need an account with Dropbox or Microsoft OneDrive. This is used as storage for your presentation content. This way, you decide for yourself who you make your content accessible to. With impress, you simply specify the share link to your media file.

"2. De QR code

The QR code is generated the moment the user uses the "Share" functionality: It contains the link to the shared file on the used cloud storage, as well as the connection to the web service impress. The image is a visual representation of this link. It is not saved or stored by us. Therefore, the user needs to save the QR code image himself if he needs it.
