

The pCon.planner web can be used on any device that has a browser installed.


We have created a user interface that uses components of the Fluent 2 Web design system.






2 Integration of pCon.catalog 2.0

Users can easily insert furniture symbols and materials from pCon.catalog 2.0 into their drawings.










3 Migration from pCon.catalog data to configurable data with prices


